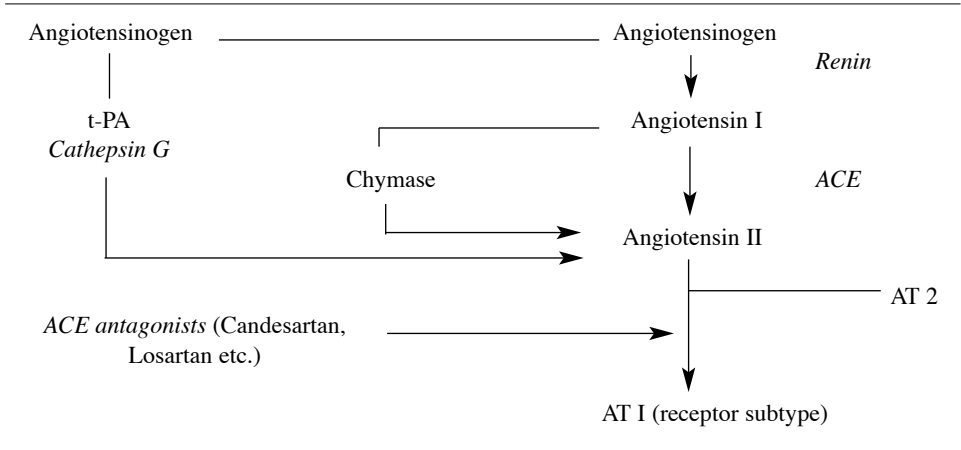


ATG — Angiotensinogen



ATDT Antithyroid drug therapy/ treatment.

ATE Acute toxic encephalopathy; Adequate therapeutic effect; Adipose tissue extract; Arterial/ Athero-thromboembolism; Autologous tumor extract; Automatic test equipment.

ATEA Arterial thromboembolic accident (see ATED).

ATED Arterial thromboembolic disease (e.g. CVA, MI, etc.); Autoimmune thyroid eye disease (see AITED).

ATEE N-acetyl-1-tyrosine-ethyl ester.

ATEM Analytic transmission electron microscopy.

Aten Atenolol.

ATEP Arterial thrombo-embolic process.

ATER Arterial thromboembolic/ism risk (see ATEA; ATED).

ATF Abnormal thyroid/ tubal (obstetrics & gynecology) function; African tick fever (a relapsing fever caused by various strains of the *Borrelia* spirochete, esp. *B. duttonii*, and also called West African relapsing fever as well as Famine, Recurrent, Spirillum or Tick fever); Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms (Bureau of); Aminotransferase; Ascites tumor fluid; Asthma Task Force; Axis traction forceps (deWeese).

ATFA Atransferrinemic anemia (= ATA).

At fib Atrial fibrillation (see Atr fib).

AT III FUN Antithrombin III functional.

ATG Active treatment group; Adenine-thymidine-guanine (antihuman) thymocyte globulin; Angiotensinogen (see Scheme); Antithrombocyte globulin; Antithymocyte globulin; Antithyroglobulin (see AAB); Aspirin-treated group.

ATGAM Antithymocyte gamma-globulin.

ATGC Adenosine, Thymine, Guanine and Cytosine (chemical aminoacid building blocks, arranged in three-letter 'words' along the length of the DNA molecule) (see AT/GC).

AT/GC Adenine-thymine/guanine-cytosine (ratio).

ATH Acetyl-tyrosine hydrazide; Allergic-type hypersensitivity (reaction).

ATh Associate in Therapy.

ATHC Allotetra-hydrocortisol.

ATHR Angina threshold heart rate.

Athsc Atherosclerosis (see ASC).

ATI Abdominal trauma index;

Active/Antitetanus immunization; Acute traumatic injury; Allograft-transmitted infection (see ATD); Alpha-trypsin inhibitor; American Tobacco Institute; Attitude(s) toward integration.

ATL Achilles tendon lengthening; Adult T-cell

- LTG** Long-term goal.
- LTGA** Left transposition of great artery.
- LTGAs** Levo-transposition of the great arteries.
- LTH** Lactogenic/ Luteotropic hormone (see Hormones - LH i); Life-threatening hemorrhage/ hypoxemia; Local tumor hyperthermia; Low temperature holding.
- LTHA** Lactose-tolerant healthy adult.
- LTHP** Long-term health problem.
- LTHR** Life-threatening hypersensitivity reaction.
- ITI** Life-threatening illness/ infection; Localized tissue irritation; Long-term illness/ immunity/ infection/ issue; Lupus-type inclusion(s).
- ITL** Laparoscopic tubal ligation; Left temporal lobe (see SPA); Life-threatening leucopenia; Long-term level; Lower tactile level (= LT).
- LtL** Layer-to-layer (suture).
- It lat** left lateral.
- LTM** Leukotriene modifier (used in asthma therapy); Life-threatening malformations (Obstetrics); Long-term maintenance/ management/ measure/ memory/ monitor(ing)/ mortality.
- LtM** Low-to-moderate (dose).
- LTMT** Long-term maintenance therapy.
- LTN** Long-term nature.
- LTNM** Long-term neurologic morbidity/ mortality.
- LTO** Long-term outcome (of an illness).
- LTOI** Life-threatening opportunistic infection (see SOI).
- LTOT** Long-term oxygen therapy.
- LTP** Laboratory test parameter/ procedure; Laser trabeculoplasty; Last trimester of pregnancy (= TTP); Leukocyte thromboplastin; Liver transplant program; Long-term pain/ palsy/ paralysis/ phase/ planning/ potentiation/ prescribing/ problem/ procedure/ prognosis/ project/ prophylaxis/ prospective/ protection; Long Term Preceptorship; L-tryptophan.
- L-TP** Lamivudine triphosphate (see NSA).
- LTPA** Leisure-time physical activity.
- LTPC** Long-term patient compliance.
- LTPE** Life-threatening psychiatric event (such as attempted suicide, suicidal ideation, etc.).
- LTPI** Leukotriene production inhibitor (= LPI).
- LTPP** Lipothiamide pyrophosphate.
- LTR** Leukotriene receptor (see CLT; CysLT); Liver transplant recipient; Long terminal repeat; Long-term record(s)/ rehabilitation/ relief/ remission/ response/ result(s)/ risk; Low transmission rate.
- LtR** Left-to-right.
- LTRA** Leukotriene receptor antagonist.
- LTRC** Leukotriene receptor antagonist.
- LTR gene.** Long terminal redundancy gene, a regulatory gene, one of the two genes of the AIDS (HIV-1) genome that contain sequences giving promotor, enhancer and integration signals (see LTRs).
- LTRs** Long terminal redundancies - stretches of DNA (or DNA sequences) that have a role in controlling the expression of the AIDS virus (three retroviral AIDS genes) (see AIDS).
- LTS** Laparoscopic tubal sterilization; Leiden Thrombophilia Study; Life-threatening situation/ stress/ stroke; Light-touch sensation; Local tolerance study; Long-term safety (of a drug)/ sequelae/ smoker/ strategy/ stress/ study (of a disease)/ success (of treatment)/ supplementation/ survival/ survivor; Lung-thorax system.
- LTSP** Long-term strategic plan.
- LTT** Lactose/ Leucine tolerance test; Lateral tibial tubercle (= Gerdy's tubercle); Limited treadmill test; Long-term therapy/ tinnitus/ treatment/ trial; Lymphoblastic/ Lymphocyte transformation test.
- LTTD** Long-term tissue destruction (as in viral myocarditis, leading to dilated cardiomyopathy).
- LTTS** Long-term toxicity study.
- LTU** Long-term use.
- LTV** London television; Long-term ventilation; Low(er) tidal volume (ventilation in ALI and ARDS); Luche tumor virus; Lung thermal volume.
- LTVA** Life-threatening ventricular arrhythmia.
- LTW** Leydig-cell tumor in Wistar rat.
- LU** Left upper (limb); Living/ Loudness/ Lytic unit; Lowry unit (see L-unit).
