

**Association of Professors of Medicine (APM):** Required components for APM Perspectives submission to *The American Journal of Medicine (AJM)*.

Thank you for considering *AJM*. Please use the following instructions as a guide. When formatting your manuscript for submission, also please refer to a recent issue of the journal to view the types of articles that are accepted for this section.

Submissions that do not conform to *AJM*'s and APM's specifications for word limit and/or format may be sent back to the author for correction before peer review.

Although there is a designated word limit for each type of submission to *AJM*, authors may be asked to shorten their text. *AJM* editors prefer tightly written articles. There is no designated table or figure limit, but please include only the data and images that are necessary to illustrate the manuscript.

All manuscripts must be submitted through *AJM*'s online submission and review system available at <http://www.ees.elsevier.com/ajm>.

### **APM Perspectives**

Abstract	No.
Word limit	2,000-2,500 words including references and figures, but not the title page.
Cover Letter	Yes. State type of article. Confirm that the manuscript has not been published and is not under consideration elsewhere. Confirm that all of the authors participated in the preparation of the manuscript.
Cover Page	Yes. Include: manuscript title, all authors and affiliations; corresponding author and full contact information; running head.
Conflict of Interest	In a separate document, state any potential conflicts of interest for each author or confirm that there are none. Each author should sign the document.
Focus	APM Perspectives articles are commentaries on issues of relevance to the internal medicine community.
Other	All references and figures should be cited in numerical order within the text. All numbers included in the text should be Arabic numerals.
	References should be noted parenthetically in the text. Do not use superscript numbers to denote a reference. Also, using a word-processing program's automatic endnote feature can create translation difficulties between different software programs (Word v. WordPerfect) and also among different versions of the software (Word 6.0 v. Word 2000). The use of personal communications as references is not encouraged. If included, they should be noted parenthetically in the text.
	If a person is mentioned in the text, please include the person's first name, graduate degrees, and job title whenever possible.
	The names of all authors, their doctoral degrees, their job titles, and their academic affiliations should be included at the end of the text prior to the references section.
	Manuscripts will be accepted for print and online publication.
