JACC: Cardiovascular Imaging will be accepting original research articles on noninvasive and invasive imaging techniques including echocardiography (surface, invasive and interventional), CT, CMR (including spectroscopy), nuclear (including PET), optical imaging, and cine-angiography; advances in basic science and molecular imaging which are likely to substantially influence the clinical practice of medicine in the next decade (in diagnostic performance, understanding of the pathogenetic basis of the disease, and therapy); state-of-the-art review articles on all aspects of CV imaging; manuscripts on advocacy and practice management as well as articles as part of a continuing series on imaging for the practicing cardiologist, future frontiers, and a range of web-based content.

Manuscripts to be considered for publication should be submitted online at <http://www.jaccsubmit-imaging.org>. The site will open for submissions beginning **July 1, 2007**.

CHECKLIST FOR MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION

Authors for **JACC: Cardiovascular Imaging** should follow the same Instructions for Authors as **JACC**.

- COVER LETTER (LETTER OF SUBMISSION)**
 - A brief discussion of the submission
 - Statements that all authors have read and approved of the paper and take full responsibility for it, that the paper is not currently under consideration elsewhere, and that it has not been previously published.
 - Full disclosure of potential conflicts of interest
- TITLE PAGE**
 - Title of Article
 - All authors' full names, degrees, and academic or institutional affiliations.
 - Full contact information (address, phone/fax, and email address) of the Corresponding Author
 - List of Key Words
 - Conflict of Interest and Financial Support disclosure statements, if applicable
- ARTICLE FILE**
 - Structured Abstract (250 words max.) for New Research papers, containing subheadings
 - Objectives, Background, Methods, Results, Conclusions
 - Unstructured abstract (250 words max.) for all other paper types
 - List of abbreviations
 - All text should be double spaced and 12 point font
 - References (double spaced starting on separate page)
 - Figure Legend with figure titles and captions
- SUPPORTING FILES (FIGURES, TABLES, VIDEOS)**
 - Figures should be of high resolution and can be uploaded in several formats
 - Figures should be marked with an identifying title (Figure 1, etc)
 - Tables should have a title (captions optional)
 - Video/cine files are encouraged
 - Letters of permission to reproduce previously published material in all forms and media
 - Letters of permission to publish patient photographs in all forms and media
