CHECKLIST FOR MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION

Authors for **JACC: Cardiovascular Interventions** should follow the same Instructions for Authors as **JACC**.

COVER LETTER (LETTER OF SUBMISSION)

- A brief discussion of the submission
- Statements that all authors have read and approved of the paper and take full responsibility for it, that the paper is not currently under consideration elsewhere, and that it has not been previously published.
- Full disclosure of potential conflicts of interest

TITLE PAGE

- Title of Article
- All authors' full names, degrees, and academic or institutional affiliations.
- Full contact information (address, phone/fax, and email address) of the Corresponding Author
- List of Key Words
- Conflict of Interest and Financial Support disclosure statements, if applicable

ARTICLE FILE

- Structured Abstract (250 words max.) for New Research papers, containing subheadings
- Objectives, Background, Methods, Results, Conclusions
- Unstructured abstract (250 words max.) for all other paper types
- List of abbreviations
- All text should be double spaced and 12 point font
- References (double spaced starting on separate page)
- Figure Legend with figure titles and captions

SUPPORTING FILES (FIGURES, TABLES, VIDEOS)

- Figures should be of high resolution and can be uploaded in several formats
- Figures should be marked with an identifying title (Figure 1, etc)
- Tables should have a title (captions optional)
- Video/cine files are encouraged
- Letters of permission to reproduce previously published material in all forms and media
- Letters of permission to publish patient photographs in all forms and media
