We would like communications that are “newsworthy”, as well as scientifically sound, and moreover, we want them to be clearly written so that solid state scientists outside the particular area would also be able to read them understandably. We do not accept “serial publications”, i.e. one paper after another on closely related subjects. To help you arrive at sensible decisions regarding publication, we suggest that you use as a guide the answers to the following questions:

Are these new results?

Does the paper contain new results which warrant rapid publication?

Will people in the condensed matter field find it interesting?

Will it have an “impact” on them?

Will it stimulate new thinking?

Will people in the field be “glad to have seen it”?

Is the paper written understandably and in reasonably correct English?

Is its length likely to exceed 6 printed pages?

Is the paper reasonably self-contained?

Does it adequately take into account existing literature?

Is the paper more appropriate for another journal?
