Acta Materialia, Inc. and its journal *Acta Biomaterialia* are pleased to announce the **Acta Biomaterialia Gold Medal Award** to recognize excellence in research and development in the field of biomaterials. With this annual award we look forward to establishing a tradition of excellence that will recognize outstanding accomplishments of investigators in the growing international biomaterials community. The **Acta Biomaterialia Gold Medal Award** will consist of the gold medal, a plaque, a cash honorarium and payment of travel expenses related to the award ceremony.

We invite nominations from the biomaterials science community for the next **Acta Biomaterialia Gold Medal Award**. The awardee should be an undisputed world leader in the field of biomaterials, whose accomplishments in discovery and translation to practice are surpassing and known to all in the field. Nominations should consist of the nominee's curriculum vitae and a letter of nomination. Seconding nomination letters are recommended, but are not essential. The selection process will be conducted by an international panel of distinguished judges and a suitable presentation venue will be arranged for the following year.

Acta Materialia, Inc. is a non-profit organization dedicated to disseminating the knowledge of science and engineering of materials, primarily by publishing high quality journals covering the areas of materials science, biomaterials, materials engineering, and materials chemistry and physics.
