In order to facilitate the preparation of index entries for your article, the journal staff is enlisting the help of the authors. We are asking you to select the subjects under which your article should be indexed. The form that is included at the bottom of the page should be completed and returned as soon as possible.

In selecting your subjects, only the title and abstract of the article being indexed should be used. Careful consideration should be given to words that are chosen for index listings. The words should be limited to those that best describe the most significant findings reported in the paper. Vague terms or those encompassing too large an area should not be used or should be categorized with an additional word. Abbreviations should not be used to replace full names in general use (e.g., Hb for hemoglobin). Widely used abbreviations (e.g., DNA, ATP) are acceptable. Examples of the appropriate listings are given below.

<u>Poor</u>	<u>Good</u>
ribonucleic acid	RNA, turnover
enzyme	Acetylcholinesterase, gallamine inhibition
kidney, rabbit	Kidney, rabbit, fructose diphosphatase distribution
COX-2	Cyclooxygenase-2, expression in chondrocytes
