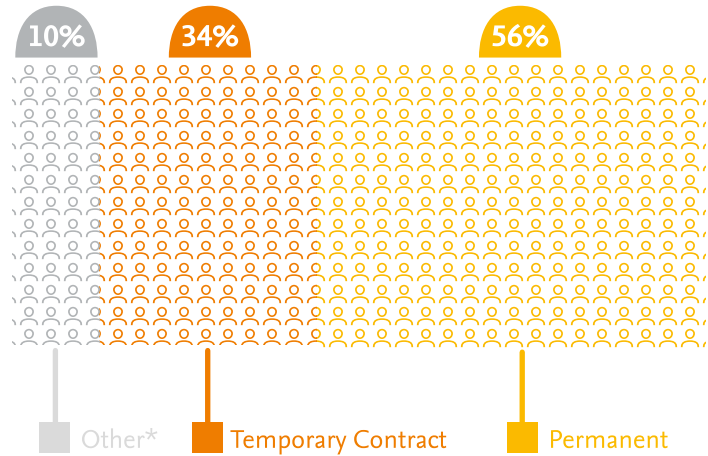

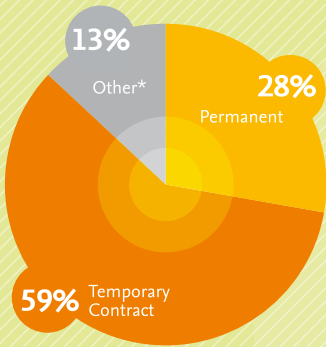

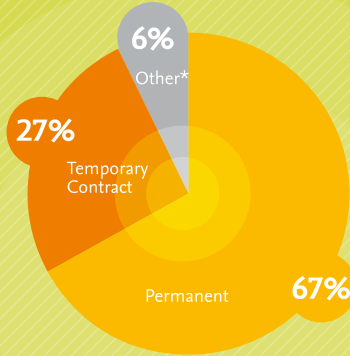

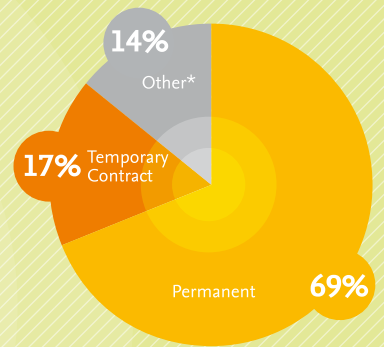

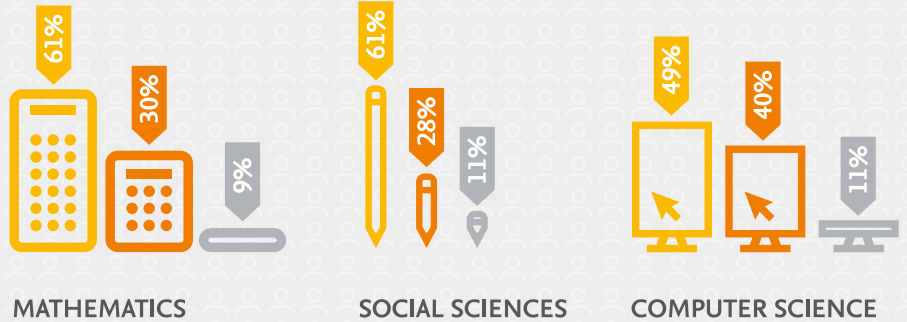
Age 37–54

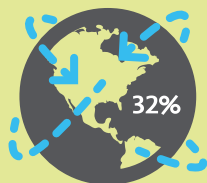

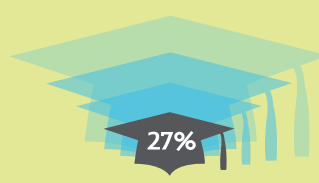
Permanent Temporary Contract Other*
