SUITABLE FILES FOR PRODUCTION

This is a Camera-Ready Copy (CRC) workflow; therefore the files that are provided need to be ready for publication according to the templates. In order to amend any manuscript, the manuscript would need to be corrected by the authors or editors. We can only accept the final version of the article.

Kindly provide each manuscript in two file formats; the source file (.doc/.docx/Latex where applies), and the PDF. Although our templates are provided in .docm format, .docm files are not suitable for production. The instructions to convert the template files to the suitable formats are mentioned at the end of the template document. The templates also contain instructions for the correct conversion to PDF format. Please note that the PDF automatically built by the EES system will not be considered for production. As the editor, we request you to inspect and make sure each manuscript has both files.

Production commences once we have the complete manuscripts in both formats.

GUEST EDITOR CHECKLIST

It is the sole responsibility of the Guest Editor to ensure that the papers uploaded to the FTP site are of suitable quality and follow the Procedia guide for authors and paper templates exactly. Elsevier will not check these uploaded papers for completeness before sending them forward for typesetting. Any errors present in papers at upload will be incorporated at the typesetting phase as

no proofs will be sent to the authors or guest editors. After the papers are published on ScienceDirect, errors cannot be corrected.

Checklist

- Are all papers ready for upload (refer number specified in contract*)?
- Do all papers use the supplied Procedia Word paper template?
- Are all papers available in Source file (.doc/.docx or LateX) and PDF formats? Please note we require both files to proceed with production, and that .docm format are not accepted.
- Is there an editorial for this Procedia? Please note all materials to be published in the issue should be submitted together with papers.
- Exclusive License to Publish: Elsevier has automated the license transfer from authors. However, please forward any copyright communication you receive via email to the Journal Manager managing the issue.
