As demand for open access grew within the scientific community, we have expanded our commitment, by adding open access publishing options to the vast majority of our 2,000+ journal publications, including the full range of Earth science titles. While this has certainly benefited authors by allowing them to publish their findings in their favourite high impact Elsevier journal, it has also removed *GeoResJ*'s principal objective. As such the decision has been made to close the journal, with authors able to publish their open access research articles in a host of specialised Earth science titles with Elsevier.
